Late Payments

As you are all aware, you have 3 weeks to pay your fees then a 10% late penalty fine and £2.50 administration fee will be added. Many parents are still paying after the 3rd week, and in some cases not paying until the 4th, 5th week. After the 4th week, we now have a policy in place that if your fees are not paid, we won't allow your Son/Daughter into their class. To avoid embarrassment on both sides, please pay fees within the first 3 weeks. If you are struggling to pay your fees, then please can you let Lisa know in reception, and we can come to some sort of arrangement – thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

SEPTEMBER TIMETABLE

Can I please ask everyone to check the date/time and studio location of their daughter/son's lessons for when we return in September as we have made a few changes to the classes etc. This was done so that we could accommodate all those who had taken their exams and avoid any timetable clashes that may have occurred. We are also operating a "Show Timetable" so some of the senior classes may be combined – all these details are listed at the bottom of your bill. Even if your daughter/son hasn't taken exam, their class time may have changed so please check before returning to classes.

BACS PAYMENTS

We have been trialling payment via bacs over this past half term and it is working incredibly well for us, so we have decided to offer this payment option for term fees. Account details are at the bottom of the bill (along with payment due dates) but I have listed everything again below for information –

We will be monitoring this very closely and hope that it makes payment much easier for you all.

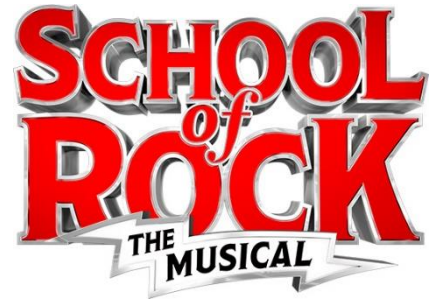
SUMMER SCHOOL

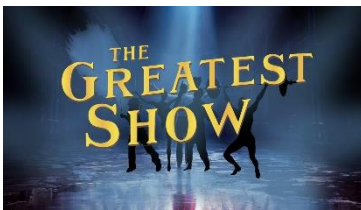

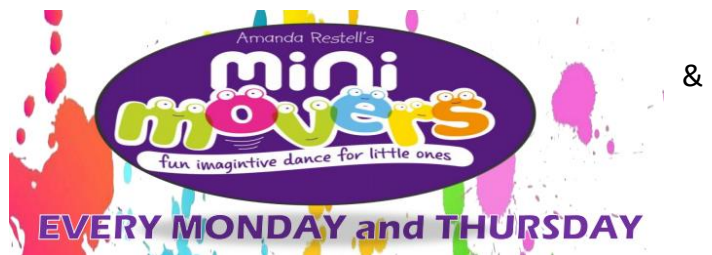

VILLAGE GREEN – Saturday 13th July

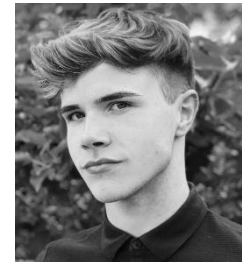
